Notes*	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • If you currently don't have a specialist on LMIA, our lawyer can handle the LMIA application with no additional charge. • The worker will be trained for 1-3 months depending on your job requirements. • The employer can request the workers pass the Meat Cutting 101 Certificate offered by Food Processing Skills Canada (FPSC), a \$1500 fee charged by FPSC may apply. • Employer can request a remote video interview before sending the job offer. • We will start looking for housing and book the flight for the workers <u>one month</u> after the Work Permit Application is submitted. • ESDC charges LMIA application fee: \$1000/spot • Legally, the employer is responsible for the foreign worker's round-trip flight ticket.

FAQs:

- What is the 2-year guarantee?
 - If the worker leaves the position for any personal reason or being fired, we will find you a replacement for free.
- How do you guarantee the workers to stay for 2 years?
 - Because it takes minimum 2 years for the workers to become a permanent resident.
- What happens after the 2 years?
 - The worker can decide whether they want to stay. After all, they already worked at the front line for 2 years in exchange for an opportunity to become a permanent resident. They will stay if you treat them well.
- How long does it take for the workers to start working?
 - 4-6 months in general, up to 8 months depending your training requirement.
- Can the workers work at other places?
 - No, the worker can only work at your place because they will have a “Closed Work Permit”, which makes it illegal for them to work anywhere else.
- Can I fire the worker?
 - Yes, you absolutely can.

FAQs:

- What if the worker doesn't meet your expectation?
 - Give them some patience and training, and we will help you talk them through.
- What if I am still not happy with the worker's performance?
 - Fire them, our lawyer will handle all the termination for you so that you don't hold and legal responsibility.
- What if the worker runs away?
 - Tell us, we will help you report to the government, and our lawyer will handle the termination paperwork
- Do they speak English?
 - Yes, as a part of the job requirement, you can request the workers to pass an English test before sending your job offer.
- How should I pay them?
 - Pay them just like how you pay your current employees.
- How many foreign workers can I hire?
 - Roughly 30% of your current full-time Canadian employees. Our lawyer will do a detailed calculation according to your payroll and tax information.

FAQs:

- Is there a fee for the lawyer to work on LMIA?
 - No, there is no additional fee on the lawyer. It is included in our service fee.
- Do I need to pay for the \$1000-LMIA application fee again if the worker leaves and we need to replace them?
 - No, LMIA is reusable within its valid period, usually 2-3 years.
- Are the workers willing to come to work in a rural area?
 - Yes, it might take longer to find the person though.
- Where do the workers live?
 - We will try our best to help the workers find housing.
- How do the workers get here?
 - We will help the workers book their flight to Canada, (Legally, the employer is responsible for the foreign worker's round-trip flight ticket.)
